- 2.3.2. However, I *think* this may be disabled by unchecking "show wall posts" as shown above on 1.1.3.
- 2.4. The bottom line is not to post anything that you don't want to share with your friends. Use email instead.
- 3. What to show in your profile...
 - 3.1. Click on "Info" on your profile. Then "Edit."
 - 3.1.1. Probably the most important is to show your birthday (so people may wish you a happy birthday" but to suppress the year.
